### Name of Activity

Shuttle Through Chinese Culture in Books

### Objective(s)

- Cultivating students' interest in Chinese culture, such as cuisine and etiquette.
- Establishing traditional values of Chinese culture.
- Fostering students' sense of identity and pride in Chinese culture.

### Brief Descriptions:

From March to May, our school invited parent volunteers to serve as "Story Aunties" and "Story Uncles" to conduct storytelling activities with students in grades N-K3 a total of five times. In each activity, the Story Aunties and Uncles, together with the teachers, selected suitable Chinese cultural stories to share with the students. These stories included "Ah Zhong Making Tofu," "Little Teapot Delivers Tea," "The King Who Loved Stamps," "White Rice Hole," and "The King's Longevity Noodles." The Story Aunties and Uncles vividly interpreted the stories and incorporated related games and activities to allow students to engage in hands-on practice based on the lessons learned from the stories and deepen their understanding of the story content.

Throughout the process, students appreciated Chinese food culture, learned values of gratitude, cherishing oneself and others, as well as traditional etiquette. Through storytelling, students were able to travel through time and explore various aspects of Chinese culture, discovering its fascinating aspects.

Student sharing: "I want to make longer, even longer longevity noodles to give to my mom, so she can live longer and stay with me for a longer time! We hold teacups with both hands. Mom, please have some tea. Don't make random stamps! People will be unhappy."
