Visting Spiral Lookout Tower

Objective(s)

- Understanding the Historical Background of Hong Kong (from British Return to China)
- Increasing student 's Attention and Awareness of Historical Events
- Cultivating Students' Sense of Identity and Belonging Towards China's Hong Kong

Brief Descriptions:

On June 26th, students from Class K3 visited the Tai Po Waterfront Park to survey the Spiral Lookout Tower. Through observing the lookout tower from a distance and then ascending the spiral wooden staircase to the top, they were able to overlook the Tolo Harbour. By reading the inscriptions, sketching, and listening to the explanations from the teacher and passersby, the students gained a more comprehensive and personal understanding of the history of how the New Territories gentry fought to defend their homeland in the early years when Hong Kong was ceded to the British, and the heroic sacrifices they made. This helped the students develop a more tangible and intimate perception of Hong Kong's return to China.
