As the learning unit "Secrets of Small Animals" begins, the K1 class ventured outdoors today to explore, observe, and learn about the animals in Hong Kong Wetland Park. The children, along with teachers and parent volunteers, moved around to observe. We saw little crocodiles, various fish swimming in the ponds, and dragonflies and butterflies fluttering around. We also entered the birdwatching hut, where we used binoculars to observe birds resting and foraging on the lake's surface. Wow! On the mudflat, we spotted fiddler crabs and mudskippers, and the children immediately recorded their findings! Allowing children to personally observe and explore nature not only stimulates their curiosity but also enhances their questioning and expression skills, promoting spontaneous learning and understanding of the world.
